The Yard runs Yard Young Artists, a theatre-making programme for local children and young people, aged 4 to 19 years. This programme is driven by a team of **lead artists** and **facilitators**:

Lead Artists

We want to hear from artists who are interested in making provocative, humane and beautiful work with young people.

We expect these to be established artists who are excited by the prospect of working with Yard Young Artists to make work that sits within The Yard's theatre programme. We're particularly keen to hear from artists who might already have ideas bubbling away.

- o A brief paragraph (200 words max) telling us a bit about:*
 - what ideas you want to explore,*
 - what work you want to make and why*
 - What interests you in the contemporary experience of young people and what it says about the world*

We will review these emails at certain times in the year. The next review date is 6-10 May, so we'll be in touch shortly after that.

Facilitators

The work we make couldn't happen without an incredible team of facilitators. Our lead artists are assisted by creative, compassionate people who look after the young people, the room and support the creation of the work. Facilitators are usually relatively early in their careers, looking to develop their artistic practice, but experienced in working with young people.

Depending on the length of session, pay is between £40-£60 p/session.
